July 6, 2010 EAA Chapter Board Meeting

Minutes: Motion by Audrey S. and Second by Herb Z. that the Minutes be approved. Motion passed.

Treasurer's report: Checking: \$1,655.12. Savings: \$1049.28. Accounting for Aviation Day was not complete at this date.

Old Business:

Aviation Day – Post Analysis. It was agreed by all that Aviation Day 2010 was a successful Father's Day event. Jim Bremer expressed his appreciation to all that participated to make it a success. A few glitches along the way were quickly resolved. National EAA insurance coverage denied having the Bouncing House. They were also concerned re: Hillside Aviation listed as co-sponsors for the event and selling airplane rides too. The Board and Hillside Aviation agreed that next year we will list Hillside as providers of rides but not as cosponsors. However, the Chapter really appreciates Hillside providing the use of their hangar for the pancake breakfast. It was estimated that about 760 breakfasts were sold. It was too early to tell exactly since the full accounting was not complete. Treasurer, Paul G. presented checks for reimbursement of expenditures Julie O. and others had for Aviation Day. Approval was by consensus.

At the last Board Meeting it had been voted on to order t-shirts for Aviation Day. After securing a quote it (Pres. Jim B) was decided the price was too high and the order was not placed. Hats for the event were not considered for this year.
